You provide the date, time, and space and we provide the rest!

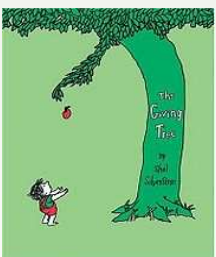
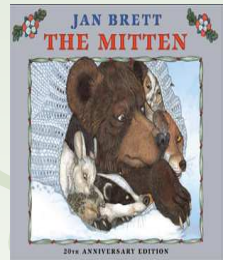


Fletcher and the Falling Leaves by Julia Rawlinson

Children learn about caring, compassion, and the wonders of the fall season in Fletcher's tale. The learning activities explore the wondrous animal and plant changes of the fall season.

The Mitten adapted by Jan Brett

The Mitten is a classic Ukrainian folk tale about a mitten that is lost by a young boy and the animals that take refuge in the mitten until it breaks! The values expressed include tolerance and cooperation. The learning activities promote understanding animal adaptations to harsh winter conditions. When it's cold outdoors, kids will warm quickly to exploring our animal artifacts!



The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein

The Giving Tree crafts a beautiful story about unfaltering love that children will understand and adults will appreciate. The values expressed include compassion and generosity. The learning activities promote understanding trees, forests, and the necessity of stewardship of forests to promote a healthy earth. This is a great activity to kick off spring 2010 and the 40th anniversary of Earth Day!
